RECIPES FOR CLASSES

CHOCOLATE CAKE

100g soft butter, 275g caster sugar, ½ tspn vanilla ext, 250g SR flour, 50g cocoa powder, 1 tspn bicarb, 3 large eggs separated, 250mls cold water, 2 x 8” aprox tins, greased and base lined.

Cream butter, vanilla and 200g of sugar until pale and fluffy.

Sift flour, bicarb and cocoa together and beat into sugar mix gradually with water and egg yolks, mix well as the mixture will be thick.

Whisk egg whites to soft peaks then add remaining 75g of sugar.

Carefully fold egg white into chocolate mixture.

Divide between cake tins, bake 25-30mins 180C, 170C fan, Gas 4. until skewer comes out clean.

Cool for 5 mins, turn out onto wire rack.

When cold sandwich together with chocolate butter icing and lightly dust with icing sugar.

GINGERBREAD

250g SR flour, 2 rounded tspn ground ginger, 2 rounded tspn mixed spice, 200g Demerara sugar, 150g butter or margarine, 150g black treacle, 2 large eggs, 150mls milk.

8” aprox round or square high sided tin, lightly greased and lined.

Sieve Flour and spices in a bowl. Stir in sugar.

In a saucepan, melt fat and treacle, pour into the dry ingredients.

Lightly beat eggs and milk, then pour into flour mixture.

Beat well until you have a smooth batter.

Pour into prepared tin, bake 50-60mins 170C, 160C fan, Gas 3. until skewer comes out clean.

Leave to cool in tin before turning out.

HONEY CAKE

150g, butter, 110g soft drown sugar, 175g clear honey, 1 tbspn water, 2 eggs, 200g SR flour, A few flaked almonds
Greased and lined tin 7 “ aprox.

Put butter, sugar, honey and water in a saucepan, heat gently until sugar and butter have melted.

Leave to cool.

Beat the eggs one at a time into cool mixture, and then stir in flour. (Do not over mix)

Pour mixture into tin. Arrange almonds on top of mixture

Bake for 1hour or until risen and firm to touch at 180C, 170C fan, Gas 4.

Turn out, remove paper and leave to cool.
