### Where did all the money go?

Following a record breaking year for The Brailles Village Show, held in August 2009, the Show Committee has reviewed all the requests for funds from local organisations. The committee is pleased that it has had sufficient funds to meet many of the requests whilst still being able to make a significant contribution to the Village Hall Funds, a long term beneficiary of the Show.

In 2009 we had a fantastic show which gave us a surplus of around £6,700 to allocate to various village organisations, the funds have been allocated as follows:

- Village Show infrastructure (Gazebo's, Signage, Ropes etc.)	£1,700
- Defibrillator Fund	£1,000
- Footpath Group (Spring Bulbs)	£35
- Brownies	£200
- Toddler Group (Table, Stacker Boxes, Dressing up Clothes)	£200
- Drama Group (Costumes & Sourcing Music/Sound Effects)	£200
- Brailles Primary School (Junior Gardening Tools, Outdoor Math's Kit)	£340
- St Georges Churchyard Group (Contribution to a new Mower)	£250
- Pavilion (Contribution to major refit)	£800
- Brailles Village Hall (Contribution to New Heating System)	£2,000
